

NCC Guidelines amendment recommendation-

Section X

Paragraph 3, P; SIGNS AND FLAG POLES

The following is guidance for permanently mounted in ground flag poles.

Permanent flag poles shall be no higher than 20' from finished grade

The proposed location of the pole must be within the "C" Zone of the residence and located in a flower or landscaped bed.

Poles must be made of stainless steel or aluminum and of one piece construction. Telescoping poles are not authorized. (plastic or wooden poles are not allowed)

Poles may be either black/white or silver in color.

Pole top ornament can be either standard ball mount, eagle, or plain.

Poles cannot have any attachments beyond the necessary halyard and truck. Nautical masts are not permitted.

The base mounting and footer must be properly engineered and submitted for review/approval by the NCC prior to any excavation.

Additional flags to the US Flag are only permitted in accordance with F.S. 720

All flags will be flown in accordance with 4 U.S Code
